**“CALIFORNIA GREEN DREAM MACHINE” - New Transportation Alternative for Gas Crisis Arrives in California**

Oceanside, California July 5th 2006 - It doesn't use any gas. It's sleek, it's environmentally friendly and it's COOL. It is called the ENVIRO-BIKE from Scooterteq Motor Corporation. ENVIRO-BIKE is one of the first low-powered electric bicycles to reach these shores that is both “street legal” and fully compliant with Consumer Product Safety Commission standards.

The bike has a range of about thirty miles on level ground and it takes only pennies to recharge with standard house current. The current cost estimate for a full thirty mile charge is about ten cents. With gas prices now stabilized at well over three dollars a gallon, owning an ENVIRO-BIKE certainly may be an alternative worth considering for many.

Expect to see these in your neighborhood soon. During the recent OFest in Oceanside on July third and fourth, crowds thronged to the booth displaying these bikes.

At 550 watts, the electric power plant is more than enough to propel these head turning little vehicles smoothly, silently and effortlessly along at twenty miles per hour. Unlike others that have come before, this baby can also take small hills effortlessly.

Going far beyond the bare bones commuter bike, ENVIRO-BIKE comes with advanced features never before seen in a similar product. Cruise control, front disk brakes and a security system with remote control are all standard features.

The Oceanside based Enviro-Bike store, owned by John Fuhrmann, opened its doors for business on the first of July. This Oceanside storefront represents the initial west coast presence for Scooterteq Motor Corporation of Houston, Texas. Scooterteq currently has successful distributorships for their electric bike products in Massachusetts, Florida, Texas and British Columbia, Canada.

ENVIRO-BIKE is street legal and requires no drivers license, insurance or registration for Operation because it is classified under California law similarly to a bicycle (DMV regulation 24016). The only restrictions are that riders must be at least sixteen years of age and must wear a CPSC approved helmet. They may be ridden anywhere that a bicycle can, with the exception of special pedestrian and bike paths which allow no motorized transport of any kind.

The Enviro-Bike store is located at 1533 South Coast Highway in Oceanside. During the store's grand opening celebration on July 15th, a “California Green Dream Machine” model will be given away in a grand prize draw to one of the individuals who has recently test driven the bike. ENVIRO-BIKE.
